SAFE STORAGE

**Medications need to be stored securely; keep them
locked up like you would a weapon or items of value.**

SAFE DISPOSAL

**Flushing unused or expired medication or putting it
down your drain allows for the medicine to get into
the water supply.**

DON'T SHARE

**Don't share your medication. Don't give it away to a
friend or family member even if they are in pain. It is
illegal and dangerous to give your medicine away.**
